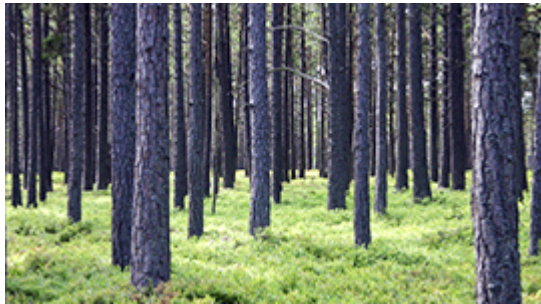

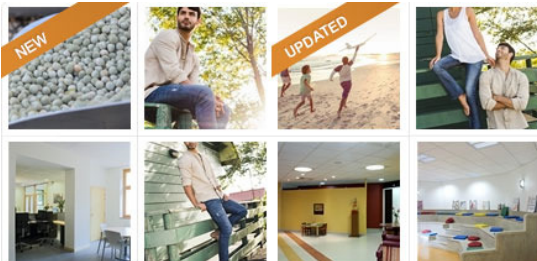
Filmop International update EPD using Italian standard UNI 11698
